Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

In 1 Corinthians 15:1-8, St. Paul reminds the church of the gospel and its work in the life of the church. Here it is, outlined for the sake of clarity:

"Now I would remind you, brothers, of

- The gospel
  - A. I preached to you.
  - B. which **you received**,
  - C. in which **vou stand**,
  - D. and by which **vou are being saved**,
    - i) if you hold fast to the word I preached to you-
    - ii) unless you believed in vain.

For I <u>delivered to you</u> as of <u>first importance</u> what

### II. I also received:

- A. that Christ **died** for our sins
  - *i) in accordance with the Scriptures*
- B. that He was **buried**
- C. that He was **raised** 
  - *i)* on the third day
  - *ii) in accordance with the Scriptures*

- D. and that He **appeared** 
  - i) to Cephas,
  - *ii)* then to the twelve,

- iii) then He appeared to more than five hundred brothers at one time.
  - (1) most of whom are still alive,
  - (2) though some have fallen asleep.
- iv) Then He appeared to James,
- *v)* then to all the apostles.
- vi) He appeared also to me,
  - (1) last of all,
  - (2) as to one untimely born."

This same gospel we too have received, preached to us by the first witnesses of the resurrection. This chapter, which begins so boldly with a declaration of the foundation of the Church, ends with two equally stirring statements:

- <sup>57</sup>"Thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ."
- <sup>58</sup>"Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain."

The church's life comes not from our acts but from God's power in the gospel. Our work is the fruit of the Holy Spirit, who leads us to desire passionately that God's will be done. May God guide you throughout this Lent and Easter season to a renewed commitment to His Word, a new dedication to His ministry, and a new zeal for His gospel.

# PENNY WAR MISSION PROJECT 2018 "SOLES FOR SOULS"

### FEBRUARY 18 - MARCH 25

On September 7, 2017, Hurricane Irma passed just north of Puerto Rico as a Category 5 hurricane, destroying thousands of homes and leaving 1 million residents without power. Two weeks, later, on September 20, Hurricane Maria passed directly over the island as a Category 4 hurricane with sustained winds of 155 mph. Additional structures that had survived Irma were destroyed by the winds. Flooding up to 15 feet followed, water supplies were cut off, and most of the agriculture of the island was destroyed. Their aging power grid was completely destroyed, plunging all of the island's 3.4 million residents into darkness. Most communication networks were cut off. The damage to the power grid was so severe that currently—five months later—almost 30% of the island remains without power, and it is estimated that it could be another eight months before all power is restored.

Amazingly, most of the schools in Puerto Rico have reopened, though many of them remain without power. Opening the schools was a priority so that the children have a safe place to go during the day. However, children cannot attend school if they do not have shoes to wear. And many families lost their clothing, shoes, and other personal belongings in the storms.

This year's PENNY WAR will raise money for SOLES FOR SOULS, a charity that provides shoes to the poor throughout the world. We will be able to designate our donations to SOLES FOR SOULS for the people of Puerto Rico. Because many of the shoes that SOLES FOR SOULS distributes are donated by shoe companies, they are able to distribute new shoes at a very low cost. In fact,

### EACH \$1.00 DONATED = 1 PAIR OF SHOES!

HOW YOU CAN HELP: There are several ways that you can donate to our mission project. ALL TYPES OF MONEY CAN BE DONATED (pennies, nickels, dimes, quarters, and paper money). Donations may be given to any of our Sunday School students for their class banks to help them earn points for their team. There will also be a donation jar located on the glass case in the chapel. March special mission envelope donations are designated for SOLES FOR SOULS. And our LOOSE CHANGE SUNDAY will be held on March 11. On that day, we will encourage those who wish to participate to leave a donation on their pew at the end of the worship service. Our students will hunt for the donations and add what they find to their class banks.

We will keep track of our Sunday School teams' progress weekly, and our final totals and winners will be announced on Easter Sunday. Of course, the REAL winners will be the children of Puerto Rico as they receive their new shoes! So let's "put on the armor of God...and shoes that prepare us to preach the good news of peace with God" (Ephesians 6). Get ready, get set, and let the fun begin!
