OUR VISION WELCOMING PEOPLE TO GROW IN HOPE, LOVE, AND CERTAINTY THROUGH GOD'S WORD OF GRACE.

Members, friends, and family of Grace,

One year ago, a tiny virus from China dealt huge consequences. Our world ground to a halt. Although some recovery has begun, it will be years, if not decades, before the ripples from this pandemic are stilled. Well-meaning (and not so well-meaning) folks in talk shows and chat groups debate whether the measures governments have taken in response have saved millions of lives or simply worsened the pain of a mostly unavoidable situation.

Here at Grace, we have tried to do the best we can with the information we have available. We've not bought into the panic of some, nor have we dismissed the danger like others. Instead, we've tried to set a course which balances the essential activities of Grace – such as the Divine Service – against a need to mitigate risk, especially for our members who are in high-risk categories. In so doing, we've looked at the big picture, willing to take reasonable precautions but refusing to be treated more strictly than casinos, restaurants, super stores, and Planned Parenthood. Your Board of Elders and I have gotten used to making decisions that have no right answer. For the most part, our congregation has been patient and understanding with us, and we thank you for that.

As facts become known, vaccinations become widespread, and the impact of the virus diminishes across our region, we have modified Grace's policy slightly. You can read the entire policy posted at the entrances to the church, but here are some highlighted changes:

- **Increased building capacity from 25% to 50%.** That means about 200 people in the sanctuary. The 50% rule applies to each room individually (e.g. just because 200 people fit in the sanctuary, doesn't mean you can put 200 people in the Ladies' Lounge).
- There are no designated entrances and exits; you may use any door.
- **Communion distribution will not involve gloves.** COVID is not spread by touch nor by ingestion, according to the best research. Gloves provide minimal/no safety benefit and make the Eucharist much more impersonal. All assistants will still thoroughly wash their hands prior to Communion. If you have any concerns, please speak with me.
- **Drive-up Communion will be offered for 15 minutes after the service.** If you need more time, call the office at 716-283-1843 and tell Erin you're coming. We'll be there for you.
- Food/Drink is permitted. Food cannot be self-serve unless individually wrapped/portioned.
- 5th Sunday Communion will resume.

We hope these adjustments will help life return a little closer to normal. Come quickly, Lord Jesus!

UPDATES:

JANUARY SPECIAL MISSION ENVELOPES were designated for Niagara Falls Meals on Wheels. We were able to donate \$865 to this local organization, which provides meals to those in our community who cannot shop or cook for themselves. This service allows many of their clients to remain in their homes in situations that would otherwise necessitate them moving to an agency setting.

FEBRUARY SPECIAL MISSION ENVELOPES resulted in being able to donate \$825 to Young Life, an international organization with a local chapter that uses adult volunteers to reach out to teens to help them discover the love that God has for them. With their annual dinner fundraiser being cancelled for two years in a row due to COVID, this help was especially appreciated!

OUR ANNUAL TOILET TISSUE PROJECT was a success again this year! Due to your generosity and a grant from Thrivent, we were able to donate 864 rolls of tissue to Heart, Love & Soul. They will be distributed to clients in need over the coming weeks. Thank you for your help and love shown toward our neighbors!

LOOKING AHEAD:

MAY SPECIAL MISSION ENVELOPES will be designated for FOOD FOR THE POOR. A former minister of Grace, Rev. Daniel Otto, was a long time volunteer with this agency. Food for the Poor is a Christian ministry that primarily serves countries in the Caribbean and Latin America, providing food, housing, healthcare, education, fresh water, and emergency relief. They strive to reflect God's unconditional love for all people. You can support Food for the Poor by using your May special mission envelope, or by donating on the Grace web page under "special mission".

Our annual support of **SUMMIT LIFE OUTREACH CENTER** will begin on Mother's Day in May and continue until Father's Day in June. Tables will be available to accept donations of new baby clothes, diapers, and baby toiletries. Summit is a Christian organization located on Pine Avenue near the Niagara Falls City Market that is devoted to helping young women who find themselves in unplanned pregnancy situations. Their clients receive free counseling as well as pregnancy and parenting education. Their "earn while you learn" program allows them to shop for needed baby items in the "Parenting Shoppe" with credits received for attendance at educational sessions. Your donations will help to stock their Parenting Shoppe.

The Magdalene Project is located on Falls Street in Niagara Falls. Magdalene was founded several years ago by Joanne Lorenzo, who felt drawn toward the woman of Niagara Falls who were working the streets as their main source of income. She began sharing the love Jesus has for them by meeting them where they were—on the streets.

Gradually her ministry has grown to include several projects. She supervises the **Rose Café**, a place where ladies from the streets can come to receive food, assurance of Christ's love, and a safe place to share their life circumstances.

Joanne regularly takes her van out to the street and visits area motels, providing a **mobile distribution** of food, clothing, and other necessities to homeless individuals.

She also offers a weekly **soup kitchen** to those in need. And she a runs a **Kidz Club** that provides a safe environment for under supervised children to receive homework assistance, snacks, and Bible stories, and provides them with needed school supplies.
